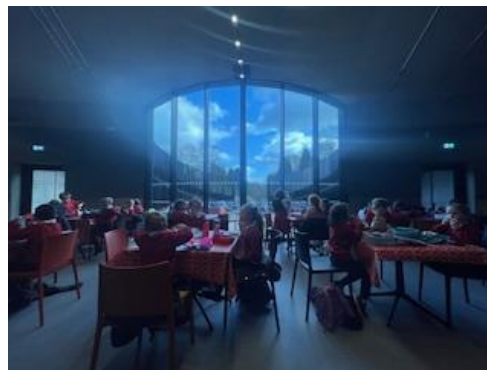


Our Easter Experience Day was lots of fun.
