Buxworth Primary School Uniform Policy

It is the policy of the school that all children will wear our agreed uniform each day. This fosters a feeling of belonging to our community, and helps children feel equal to each other. When developing this policy the school has taken into account the latest DFE guidance <https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/school-uniform>

At Buxworth, we expect our pupils to be dressed cleanly and smartly, wearing the appropriate school uniform:

- red sweatshirts or cardigan bearing the school logo
- white polo shirts or school shirts
- grey or black trousers, shorts, skirts or pinafore dresses
- sensible black footwear
- In summer months Red/white checked cotton dresses are also permitted

Our uniform stockists are 'Headmasters' in New Mills.

PE Kit:

- Plain red T-shirt
- Black shorts
- Black pumps or trainers
- Black or grey tracksuit tops/bottoms for outdoor work

If your child represents the school at a sports event, then school kit is provided.

Jewellery

Jewellery **should not** be worn to school. Exceptions are made for watches and stud earrings but these should be removed for any PE activity. On no account must studs be worn at the swimming baths. In order to avoid problems at school, it is advisable to have ears pierced only during a long holiday.
