

Maths

By the end of this term, we will have covered:

- Solve addition and subtraction problems in a range of contexts.
- Multiples of 1000.
- Understand place value within numbers with up to 7 digits.
- Order, compare and calculate with numbers up to 8 digits.
- Rounding and solving problems with numbers up to 7 digits.
- Draw, compose and decompose shapes.
- Area, perimeter, position and direction.

English

This term we will be revisiting everything we have learnt in Writing so far and looking at the structure of a range of genres such as recounts, reports, instructions and narratives. We will then use our topic to practise writing a variety of pieces, thinking carefully about features we would like to see in Year 6 writing.

As well as this we will spend time mastering a range of skills in reading, handwriting, spelling and SPaG, as we begin to prepare for our Summer term quizzes!

Science

This term we will be learning about the following:

Animals Including Humans: the human circulatory system, functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood. We'll be looking at the impact of diet, exercise, drugs on our bodies function.

Properties and Changes of materials: Looking at solids, liquids and gasses, dissolving and separating solutions (evaporation, sieving and filtering). We'll look at how some materials change state and decided which of these are reversible or irreversible changes.

PE and Forest School

In PE Mr Swann will be helping you to train like an Olympian with different track and field skills: running, jumping, throwing and catching. We will also be practising a range of attacking and defending games. We will continue to take part in Forest school activities with Mr Roots.

MYTHS AND MONSTERS: Ancient Greece



Art and D&T

In Art we will continue to create sketch books, experimenting with pattern, colour and shading/texture and we will then use these skills to design and create Ancient Greek vases. In D&T we will design, make, test and review our own toy for an Ancient Greek child.

RE

The two units we will be covering this term will be: What would Jesus do? Can we live by the values of Jesus in the 21st Century? And What matters most to Christians and Humanists?

History and Geography

In History we will be studying Ancient Greece and its impact on the modern world, using different sources to evidence to deduce information about the past.

In Geography we will be locating countries in Europe, creating maps using symbols and keys and comparing Greece now and then, looking at key human and physical characteristics.

Computing

Computing is about coding this term – we will be learning how to navigate labyrinths and mazes using code.

PHSE Safeguarding

We will start the year by exploring our varied and ever-changing emotions and learn how to recognise and cope with them. We will also look at keeping our bodies safe and healthy.

British Values and Project 25

Over the term, we will look at all our Project 25 values, along side the core British Values during our house assemblies.

Music

We will be learning about rhythm, pitch, composition and tempo in music this term – we will perform our songs and compositions with instruments throughout the term.

French

We will be learning key vocabulary for Olympic events (Le Joyeux Olympics) and then go on to compose short sentences about what we like to do at the weekend (Le Weekend).
