By the end of this topic we will learn..

Communication and Language

Interact with others, negotiating plans and activities and taking turns in conversation.

Enjoy listening to and using spoken and written language, and readily turn to it in their play and learning.

Sustain attentive listening, responding to what they have heard by relevant comments, questions or actions.

Listen with enjoyment, and respond to stories, songs and other music, rhymes and poems and make up their own songs, rhymes and poems.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Learn that in relationships we sometimes get on and sometimes fall and how to deal with that. We will learn to think of ways to sort things out when we don't agree.. We will also learn how to express feelings when angry and how to make myself feel better when angry.

R.E

We will consider and discuss how we show respect for one another? How we show love/how do I know I am loved? Who do you care about? How do we show care/how do I know I am cared for? How do you know what people are feeling?

Literacy- Writing

Phase 3 digraphs. We will be consolidating Phase 2 daily and using them to become more proficient in writing words, captions, labels and sentences. We will learn how to read and write Reception tricky and high frequency words.

We will learn how to write lists, information reports, letters, facts, posters and stories. We will become confident at writing our names.

Literacy-Reading

Children will have learnt all of Phase 2 and many Phase 3 digraphs and be using them confidently to read words. They will be more fluent in reading sentences.

Children will be able to answer questions about what they have read and listened to.

Maths

Children will have become more secure in their understanding of numbers to 10 and have moved on to numbers to 15. . They will be counting to 20 and beyond. They will have learnt to add and subtract numbers to 10 and compare numbers to 10. They will be confident in using measure to find how long, high and wide things are. They will understand distance and weight.

Understanding of The World

What can we find beyond the sky? What's in Space and how will we get there? Which planet do we live on? What makes Earth special? What would it be like to visit the moon? How does the moon affect the Earth? What are stars? Which star is the most important for our planet?

We will learn about the first man on the moon and the first moon landing. We will learn about how the moon affects our lives through gravity and the impact on tides. We will learn how the sun causes night and day, the seasons and the weather.

Physical Development

We will learn to develop our gross and fine motor muscles through daily physical activities and P.E lessons. We will learn to control and manipulate our bodies by using apparatus to travel along and through and to climb up, under and over. We will increase our stamina, skills and strength through regular running and speed games. We will develop ball skills and control and develop basic gymnastic skills.

We will enjoy playing simple team games such a tig and dodgeball. .

Expressive Art and Design
