

**HISTORY** We will be studying The Great Fire of London. The children will be researching how it started, the causes and the aftermath. We will make comparisons between how people lived then and now.

### **RE and BRITISH VALUES**

The children will study how different countries celebrate festivals such as Christmas. We will share comparisons about cultural beliefs in other parts of the world compared with our own family traditions at home.

**ART, DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY** The children will be making their own 'Great Fire of London' model towns using junk modelling materials. We will plot on our model towns to show where and how the fire started so they can get a real sense of geographical awareness and the expanse of the fire! We will also be painting some impressive firework pictures!

## **Welcome to the Winter Term!**

This term we will be continuing our Enchanted Woodland topic but with lots more tradition tales with a wintery twist as well as performing our own Nativity! The children will learn about why we remember Bonfire Night, what happened in The Great Fire of London and how people celebrate festivals around the world!

## **The Enchanted Woodland** *Winter Festivals*

**SCIENCE** We will be classifying objects that are living, dead and never been alive. The children will be mapping various habitats and identifying what species live there. We are also going to explore microhabitats!

**GEOGRAPHY** we are studying the continents and countries, oceans and seas. As well as comparing various climates within the northern and southern hemisphere.

**ENGLISH** The children will be reading and writing about traditional tales in the woods such as Goldilocks and the three bears and the magic porridge pot.

**MATHS** The Children will be following the Maths mastery scheme, 'Power Maths'. The term we will be looking at money, multiplication and division and statistics. Please feel free to help your child by letting them buy something using real money!
