We will have Derbyshire's music service teaching us music this term – brass instruments. We will also be learning patterns and rhythms for singing and performance.

Computing

We will be looking at staying safe online and also drawing and publishing software – drawing, inserting and manipulating items in computer programs.

The Natural world

(Blooming Marvelous & Under the Sea)

This term we will be learning all about our natural world: plants, animals, earthquakes, volcanoes, land use and much, much more! Our class texts will be 'Journey to the River Sea' and 'Rhythm of the Rain'.

Maths

Science

- The digestion system in humans
- The different types of teeth and their function in humans and animals.
- Food chains – producer, predator, prey.

English

During this topic we will be focusing on the following:

- Narrative: Traditional Tales – Jack and the Beanstalk
- Diary entries – Dougal's Deep Sea Diary
- Non-chronological report of an imaginary sea creature
- Easter Poetry
- Handwriting
- Reading comprehension skills

RE and PSHE
