

Sparkly Snow

Cloud Dough Recipe



You will need:

4 cups of flour (ideally use cornflour for a whiter dough, but plain/all-purpose flour will also work)

1 cup of oil (baby oil is suitable and is good because it doesn't have any colour, but vegetable oil would be better for children who may put it in their mouth)

Edible blue and white winter-themed cake sprinkles

To extend play further, add small world characters to make a winter scene

Method:

1. Put all the flour and oil in a bowl.
2. Stir the mixture together until you create a crumbly-textured dough.
3. If necessary, add more oil to bring the ingredients together.
4. Add the winter-themed cake sprinkles and mix into the dough.
5. Let the fun commence! You can squeeze it together and it will hold its shape and then use your fingertips to make it crumbly again.
