

Music

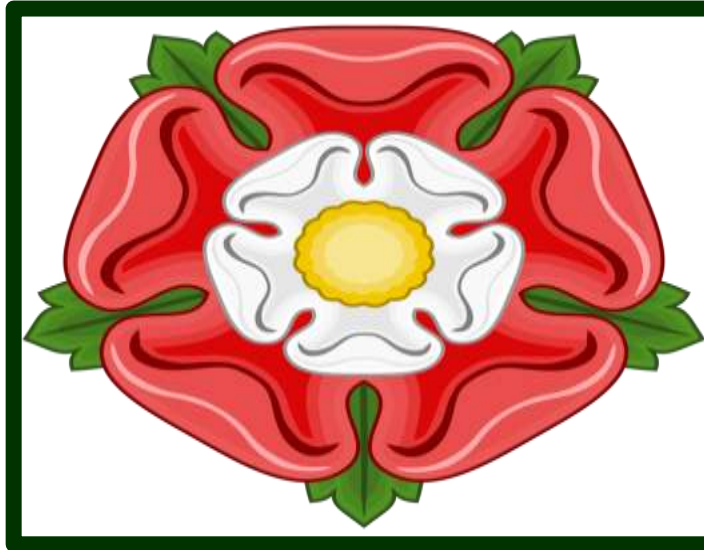
We will be looking at a variety of Tudor instruments. We'll be listening to classic music from this period in history before going on to compose our own pieces. We will also be learning by heart, a small selection of Tudor songs to be performed during our school trip.

Computing

Using coding technology, we will be making our own quiz games based on Henry VIII and his six wives. We will also be exploring online safety and publishing techniques.

The Tudors: Off with your head!

In this topic we'll be exploring the period in British history where the Tudor's ruled. We'll be visiting Bramall Hall and reading the class text 'My Friend Walter'.



Maths

By the end of this term we will have covered:

- Decimal fractions:
 - identify, compare and order tenths and hundredths
 - Add and subtract decimal numbers (up to 3 decimal places)
 - Round decimals to the nearest whole number
 - Convert between measures
- Negative numbers:
 - Calculating intervals which include negative numbers
 - Negative numbers on a co-ordinates grid
- Multiplying 2 and 3 digit numbers
- Problem solving

Safeguarding

The children will be looking at ways of keeping themselves safe in a digital and physical world.

Buxworth Values and Project 25

We will be re-introducing each project 25 value this term and look at how these line up with Core British Values.

Science

This term we will be studying:

Animals and Humans

Changes in humans as they develop into old age. Puberty and gestation periods of animals and humans.

Living things

Classifying and sorting living things including micro-organisms, animals and humans. Looking at vertebrates and invertebrates and we'll be studying the work of Carl Linnaeus.

English

During this topic we will be focusing on the following:

- Non-chronological reports
- Historical Narrative
- Persuasive writing
- Recounts of our school trip
- Poetry

History and Geography

We will be exploring Tudor monarchs, timelines, changes in Britain, food and leisure, crime and punishment, the break with Rome, Tudor explorers and their discoveries. In Geography we will looking at the UK - naming and locating counties and cities. Physical and human features, topographical features, land use patterns and how all of this has changed over time. We will explore maps and the journeys of Tudor explorers.

French

During this term we will be learning to use short sentences, use familiar vocabulary, phrases and basic language structures. We will also look at some topic based French words.

PE

Mr Swann will be teaching Tudor style dance in PE, along with both indoor and outdoor team games.

RE

We will be looking at Christianity and Islam this term. We will be using the Key Questions 'What would Jesus do?' and 'What does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today?' taken from the Derbyshire Agreed Syllabus.

PHSE

We'll be looking at 'difference and diversity' and linking this to Core British values. We will also look at the topic 'Being me' – what makes me, me?

Art and Design Technology

We will be studying portraits, specifically by Hans Holbein and then creating our own self-portraits using water colours and oil pastels. We will then go on to explore our woodworking skills to design and make picture frames to hang our portraits.
