Christmas time and the learning still continues within the school (just in a wintery manner!)-

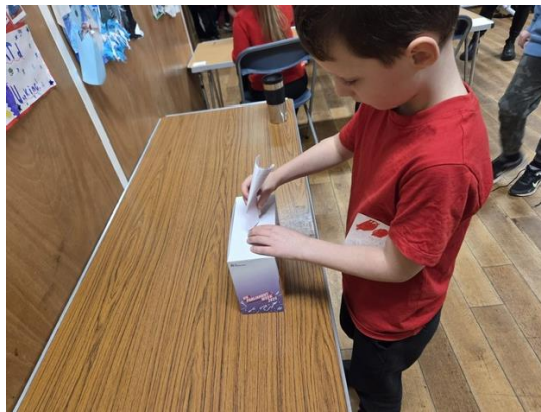
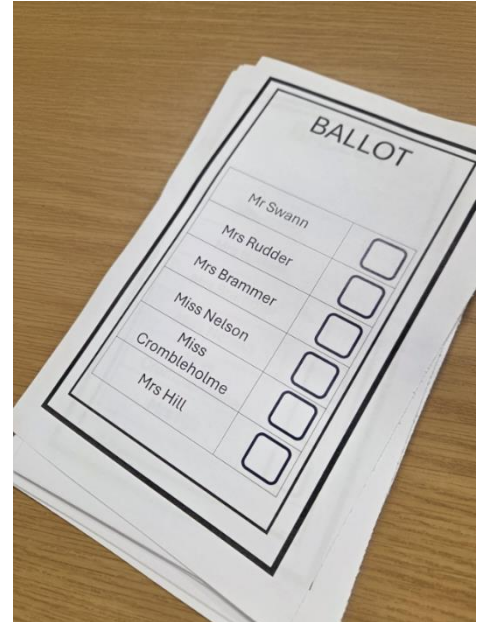


Congratulations to the Cross Country Team who represented the school brilliantly!
