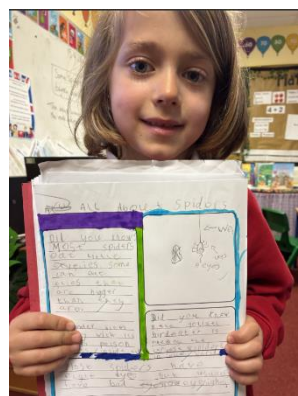
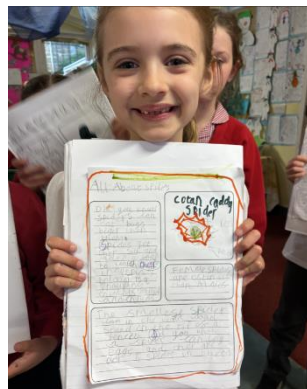
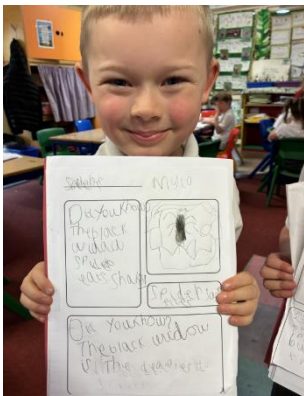
NEWSLETTER 13 – Friday 17th of April
