Dear Parents,

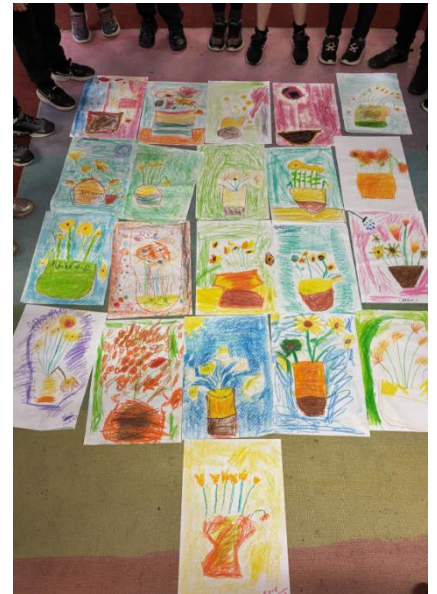
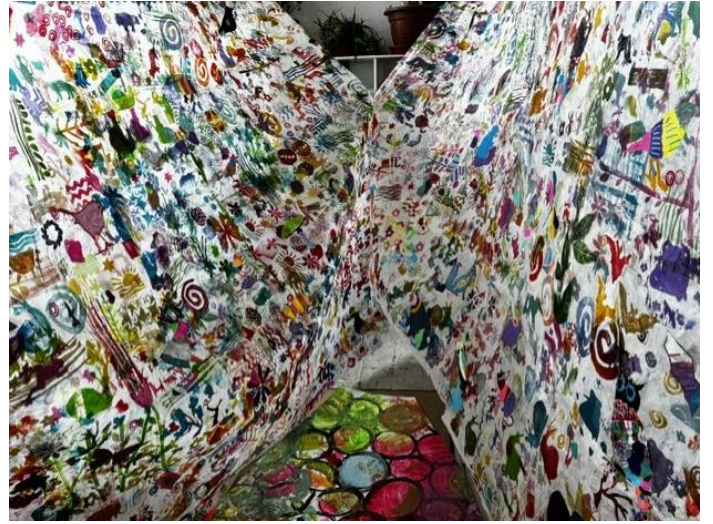
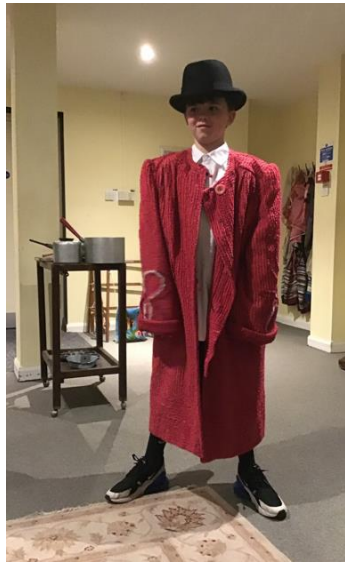
Firstly, let me begin by saying well done to all our Year 6s for completing their quizzes, we are all very proud of you.
