Congratulations to the Girls' Team who secured silver position at the recent regional finals.



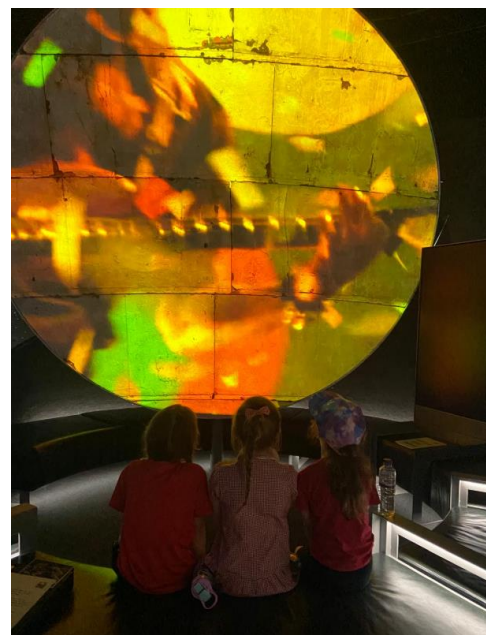
Also, a brilliant job was completed by Quad Athletics Team who competed this week at the regional finals, finishing in bronze position.
